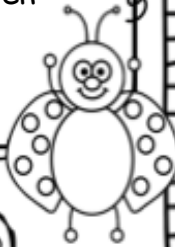
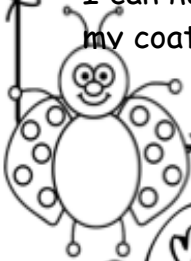


**Coat Challenge 2020 from Mon 24th

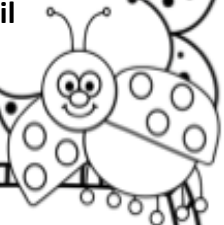
